Like many nonprofits, Child of this Culture Foundation found itself coming back to its roots in 2020. The global pandemic impacted our ability to serve our audiences personally and slowed and suspended the capacity for executing our planned programming across the nation. Nevertheless, we were able to come together to support fundraising efforts for natural disaster relief, establish the COVID-19 resources landing page on our website, and sponsor Rock da Floor Virtual youth battles. Additionally, we connected the team to discuss Hidden Bias in June and highlighted our position against sexual harassment and violence across our Hip Hop community. Since its inception in 2012, we have operated as a virtual organization with founders Candy Foelix and Cindy Foley, Board members, and most volunteers geographically separated. It's incredible how, as a grassroots organization, we have found ways to serve volunteers and communities worldwide by keeping it simple and learning to improve communication and priorities.
